Noson Agored yn Uned Iechyd Meddwl newydd Wrecsam

Mae'r Uned Iechyd Meddwl Pobl Hŷn yn Ysbyty Maelor Wrecsam bron a bod yn barod.

Dechreuodd y gwaith ar yr uned ychydig dros flwyddyn yn ôl fel rhan o brosiect £21.3 miliwn, i ddarparu cyfleusterau cleifion mewnol iechyd meddwl i oedolion a phobl hŷn ar y safle. Rhagwelir bydd yr uned oedolion yn barod yn niwedd 2010.

Mae defnyddwyr gwasanaeth a staff wedi chwarae rhan fawr yn cynllunio'r cyfleusterau newydd. Yn ogystal â darparu amgylchedd gwell, bydd yr unedau newydd yn galluogi cyflwyno ymagweddau newydd i ofal iechyd meddwl.

Open Evening at new Wrexham Mental Health Unit

The new Older Persons Mental Health Unit at Wrexham Maelor Hospital is nearing completion.

Work started on the unit just over a year ago as part of a £21.3 million project to provide new mental health inpatient facilities for both adults and older persons on the site. The adult unit is due for completion in late 2010.

Service users and staff have played a major part in drawing up the design of the new facilities. As well as providing an enhanced environment, the new units will allow new approaches to mental health care to be introduced.

It is planned that the first patients will move in on 1st March. Before this takes place there will be a chance for members of the public to visit the new buildings and be given a guided tour of the new facilities.

The open day will take place between 4:00pm and 6.30pm on Tuesday 9th February. Anyone who wishes to see the unit is welcome to come along on that day and meet up in the Main Entrance to the Unit, which is located on the north part of the Hospital site through entrance gate 5.
