### Canolfan Iechyd Newydd yn Agor yng Nghei Connah

Mae'r trefniadau terfynol yn cael eu gwneud i'r Ganolfan Gofal Cychwynnol newydd yng Nghei Connah, yn barod i dderbyn y cleifion cyntaf yn gynnar ym mis Mehefin.

Mae *Canolfan Iechyd y Cei*, sy'n werth £8 miliwn ar Ffordd Fron yng Nghei Connah. Mae'n gartref newydd i dair meddygfa yn y dref:

- Dr Harney a Phartneriaid ym Meddygfa Ffordd Fron,
- Dr Morris a Phartneriaid ym Meddygfa St Marks Dee View a
- Dr Lodhi ar Stryd Fawr Cei Connah

Mae'r adeilad newydd hefyd yn cymryd lle'r clinig presennol yng Nghei Connah. Mae caffî hefyd wedi'i gynnwys yn y ganolfan, a datblygwyd fferyllfa newydd yn adeiladau swyddfeydd cyngor y dref gerllaw.

Er bydd y meddygfeydd yn rhannu nifer o'r cyfleusterau yn y ganolfan newydd, byddant yn parhau fel tri phractis ar wahân a bydd ganddynt eu manau penodedig o fewn yr adeilad. Bydd cleifion yn parhau i fod wedi'u cofrestru â'u meddygfa bresennol.

Mae'r adeilad newydd yn cynnig nifer o fanteision i gleifion a staff: cyfleusterau modern, cyfforddus braf, sy'n cyrraedd y safonau diweddaraf ar gyfer mynediad i'r anabl; lle ychwanegol ac ystafelloedd ymgynghori ychwanegol i ganiatáu i wasanaethau gael eu hymestyn yn y dyfodol a systemau TG a chyfathrebu modern. Mae dod â'r meddygfeydd ynghyd mewn un adeilad yn creu cyfle i gyflwyno gwasanaethau newydd, mwy arbenigol na fyddai'n ymarferol i unrhyw un ohonynt yn unigol.

Mae'r ganolfan hefyd yn cynnwys cyfleusterau ar gyfer hyfforddi staff a bwriedir defnyddio'r rhain gan nifer o feddygfeydd lleol yn ogystal â phartneriaid mewn iechyd a gofal cymdeithasol i gryfhau trefniadau gweithio ar y cyd.

Dyweddodd Dr Mark Harney:

“Rydym yn edrych ymlaen yn fawr iawn at gael symud i mewn i adeilad o'r radd flaenaf, sy'n addas i ymarfer meddygaeth yn yr 21ain Ganrif.

“Mae'n debyg nad oes gwell canolfan iechyd yng Nghymru”

## **New Health Centre opens in Connah's Quay**

The finishing touches are being applied to the new Primary Care Centre in Connah's Quay, ready for it to receive its first patients in early June.

The £8million *Quay Health Centre* is located on Fron Road in Connah's Quay. It provides new accommodation for the three GP practices in the town:

- Dr Harney & Partners at the Fron Road Surgery,
- Dr Morris & Partners at St Marks Dee View Surgery and
- Dr Lodhi on Connah's Quay High Street

The new building also replaces the existing Connah's Quay clinic. A café has also been included in the centre while a new pharmacy has been developed in the adjacent town council offices building.

Although the practices will share many of the facilities in the new centre, they will carry on operating as three separate practices and they will have their own dedicated areas within the building. Patients will stay registered with the same practice they are currently with.

The new building provides many benefits for both patients and staff: pleasant modern, comfortable facilities which meet the latest standards for disability access; extra space and additional consulting rooms to allow services to be expanded in the future and modern IT and communication systems. Bringing the practices into a single building creates the opportunity to introduce new, more specialised services that would not be viable for any one of the practices in isolation.

The centre also includes facilities for staff training and it is intended that these will be used by a number of local GP practices as well as partners in health and social care to support and strengthen joint working arrangements.

Dr Mark Harney said:

"We are delighted at the prospect of moving into a state of the art building, fit for the practice of medicine in the 21st Century.

"There is probably no better health centre in Wales"
