Dydd Iau 8 Gorffennaf 2010

Wrth i'r digwyddiad Rocio'r Wyddfa IV (gyda chefnogaeth Barclays) agosáu eleni, bydd Mike Peters yn gwneud '*buskathon*' acwstig yn ystod amseroedd ymweld tri phrif ysbyty Gogledd Cymru.
