Chwilio am feddygon newydd i feddygfeydd Cefn Mawr a Glannau Dyfrdwy

Cyn do hir, bydd Bwrdd Iechyd Prifysgol Betsi Cadwaladr yn cychwyn ar y broses o benodi meddygon teulu newydd i ddarparu gwasanaethau meddygon teulu yn ardal Cefn Mawr, i'r de o Wrecsam ac yng Nghanolfan Feddygol Glannau Dyfrdwy.

Ers ymddeoliad Dr Husain ym mis Ionawr a Dr Das ym mis Chwefror 2010, bu'r Bwrdd Iechyd yn rhedeg y gwasanaethau hyn dros dro. Ond y bwriad bob amser oedd i feddygon teulu redeg y meddygfeydd yn barhaol.

New doctors sought for Cefn Mawr & Deeside practices

The Betsi Cadwaladr University Health Board will shortly be starting the process to appoint new GPs to provide family doctor services in the Cefn Mawr area south of Wrexham and at Deeside Medical Centre.

The Health Board has been running these services, on a temporary basis, since the retirement of Dr Husain in January and Dr Das in February 2010. However the intention has always been for GPs to take over the practices on a permanent basis.

We are writing to all patients with the practices to let them know that this process is about to start, and to invite them to let us have their views on questions such as:

- Would you prefer to have the option to see a female GP?
- Are there any particular services that you would want the new practice to offer?
- Do you have any suggestions for other improvements that you would like us to discuss with the new doctors?

We will also be seeking the views of the Community Health Council, local Councillors and other interested parties when considering the applications.

The Health Board will consider proposals from existing local GP Practices, as well as applications from doctors who would be new to the area. Their proposals may include continuing to provide services from the current locations (Cefn Mawr clinic and Deeside Medical Centre) or setting up the practice at another address within the practice area and within a reasonable distance of the existing surgery.

As well as being suitably qualified and meeting all necessary conditions for working as a GP in Wales, the successful candidates will have to assure us that they will have arrangements in place to provide a full range of general medical services across their practice area.

The existing services will continue to operate as usual while the appointment process is carried out.
